Statement of Purpose and Values

MHX Entertainment is committed to delivering professional wedding and event entertainment while operating responsibly, reducing avoidable environmental impacts and supporting the venues and communities in which we work.

- Act with integrity, transparency and accountability.
- Measure and report our environmental impact proportionately.
- Reduce emissions before considering any offsetting.
- Use resources efficiently and extend equipment life.
- Maintain respectful, inclusive and responsible relationships with clients, venues and suppliers.
- Review our approach annually and improve the quality of our data over time.

Scope and Initial Baseline

MHX Entertainment's initial operational reporting period begins on 1 December 2025, when event delivery commenced, and runs to 7 June 2026.

Initial operational emissions were calculated at 0.122 tCO₂e. This is a partial-period operational baseline covering event transport and attributable business electricity; it is not presented as a full-year footprint.

The calculation uses the UK Government GHG Conversion Factors 2025. Recorded information was used where available, with clearly identified reconstructed mileage and proportionate estimates where direct readings were unavailable.

Current Commitments

- Paperless booking, contracts, planning, invoicing and client communications.
- Use of low-wattage sound equipment and LED lighting.
- Rechargeable batteries and wireless lighting controls where suitable.
- Use of an electric vehicle for suitable events and a Euro 6 diesel van where load capacity requires it.
- Efficient route planning and avoidance of unnecessary journeys.
- Rooftop solar generation, an Intelligent Octopus Go tariff, solar export and on-site EV charging.
- Preventative maintenance, protective covers and repair-first equipment management.
- Responsible recycling of batteries and electrical equipment when end-of-life disposal becomes necessary.

Forward Objectives

- Maintain complete mileage records for every business journey.
- Increase the proportion of suitable events completed using electric transport.
- Reduce diesel mileage from the first full-year baseline.
- Continue zero-paper routine administration.
- Review emissions annually and publish updated results.
- Prioritise practical reduction measures before considering verified offsetting.

- Reduce operational emissions by at least 15% by 2030 against the first complete 12-month baseline.

Social and Industry Responsibility

Sustainability extends beyond carbon measurement. MHX Entertainment is committed to fair and transparent business conduct, accessible and inclusive service, safe working practices, respectful treatment of venue teams and guests, and compliance with venue sound and operating requirements.

We seek long-term relationships with venues and suppliers that demonstrate responsible environmental and social standards. Our Sustainability Policy and Carbon Reduction Plan provide further detail and are made publicly available through our website.
